The same rule applies to Practical Section 1 shotguns, however a 3 shot capacity will still be competitive.

The Clay comp December 20 is for Black powder cartridges only, side by side shotguns.

BISLEY SHOOTS

Club President, Ken Hart has followed tradition by organising the annual pilgrimage to the hallowed halls of Bisley. These competitions are open to all members.

THIEPVAL TROPHY 2015

It has been arranged for the above trophy to take place at NRA Bisley ranges 28th March 2015. The competition is for "as issued" military rifles of any age or calibre or country, with ammunition "in the spirit of the original".

Shooting as follows:

Saturday morning 28th March Century Range 600 yards

There will be prizes for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} , places the competitor who has the highest score will be deemed the winner. In the event of a tie, the highest number of V Bulls will be the winner. The competition will be judged on the best string of 10 shots fired. A string will consist of 2 Sighters, followed by 10 shots. Sighters may be converted; however, they must be converted before continuing. A range fee of £10.00 per session will be made to offset NRA range fees.

PRESIDENTS CUP 2015 28/29 March 2015

Shooting as follows:

Practice Saturday afternoon 28th March Stickledown range 1000yds

Competition Sunday morning 29th March Stickledown range 1000yds

The competition winner will be judged on the best string of 10 shots fired at 1000yds. A string will consist of 2 Sighters, followed by 10 shots. Sighters may be converted. However, they must be converted before continuing. In the event of a draw the highest number of V Bulls will be the winner. A range fee of £10.00 per session will be made to offset NRA range fees.

METCALFE AGGREGATE CUP 2015 3/4th October 2015

Shooting as follows:

Moorsholm Plaque Saturday morning 3rd Century range 300 yards Redcar Range Plaque Saturday afternoon 3rd Century range 600 yards Norman Sudron Plaque Sunday morning 4th Stickledown range 1100 yards

There is a first place prize for each of the three distances however; the Metcalfe Cup winner will be the competitor who has the highest aggregate score over the three distances. In the event of a tie, the shooter with the highest number of V Bulls will be the winner. The competition will be judged on the best string of 10 shots fired. A string will consist of 2 Sighters, followed by 10 shots. Sighters may be converted; however, they must be converted before continuing. A range fee of £10.00 per session will be made to offset NRA range fees.

ACCOMODATION FOR ALL THE ABOVE BISLEY SHOOTS AS FOLLOWS:

NRA Huts. Approx £25 per person, per night, to be paid on arrival. Must be booked in advance. THE CANADIAN PAVILION. Ken has arranged Bed & Breakfast accommodation at the Canadian Pavilion for a total of £30.00 per night included in the price is a full English breakfast and the use of the Canadian Pavilion's armoury for cleaning guns etc. The Canadian Pavilion is the third building on your right when you enter Bisley camp.

<u>Travelling</u> It is suggested that members travel on Friday morning to enable them to check their zero on Short Siberia on Friday afternoon. Shooting commences at 0830hrs Saturday morning. Meals, including breakfast, lunch and dinner can be taken in the Canadian Pavilion main building. There are also bar facilities at the Canadian Pavilion.
