Club subs will increase on January 1st 2015 to £100 per member.

The use of 17 HMR firearms at Moorsholm is <u>strictly forbidden</u> as the muzzle velocity generated exceeds the range limits. 17 HMR = 2550 ft. per second. Range limit is 2150 ft. per second.
